In India there are 2533 distinct people groups. Following are two of the groups.

Yadav



The Yadav people from all over the country trace their descent to the Krishna of Yadu lineage. They are also known as Ala Golla, PooneGolla, MongGolla, Idaiyar, Konarulu, Pillai, Nayudu, Naikan, Gwala and Yadukulam, etc.

The Yadav of the South speak Dravidian languages, practice Dravidian kinship. Those of the North speak languages of the Indo-Aryan family and are generally vegetarian.

The Yadav consist of both landowning and landless people. Their traditional occupation is animal husbandry and selling its products. Child labour is common among them. Agriculture, business, trade and self-employment are their present occupation. Some Yadava are businessmen, teachers, doctors, engineers and political leaders.

The Yadav live in joint families. They cremate dead and observe pollution period for thirteen days. However, in Kerala the Yadavcommunity bury the dead and observed death pollution for six days. They have caste associations at the regional and national levels.


The Yadav participate in the local traditional and socio-religious festivals. They are known to have more faith in astrology and talismans rather than in the services of a doctor. They have expertise in oral traditions like Sevagaridi or group singing in

praise of the god Vishnu. Similarly, they are good in musical dance and mock-fighting with swords. Boys are favored for formal education.

Several teams of workers will be needed for this large community that speaks many languages. Pray for workers.


Pray for the followers of Christ. There are a few followers of Christ among the Teli community, pray they will hunger to learn of Christ, and follow Him wholeheartedly.
